

# Kentridge High School Senior Night Party 2010!

## Graduates and Parents.....here's what you need to know!

The **Kentridge PTSA** Senior Night 2010 Planning Committee is looking forward to a fun, safe and substance-free all night celebration after the graduation ceremony on June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2010. The following information should answer questions you may have. It is imperative that both parents and participating seniors read and understand this. **What is the Senior Night Party?** The purpose of the all night senior party is to provide a fun, unforgettable and safe night for your senior student. This event is zero tolerance of drugs, alcohol or tobacco use. This is not a school-sponsored event, but has been organized by the KR PTSA planning committee and school rules apply. Dress code is casual, but appropriate dress is expected. Students are not allowed to leave the event at any time. Similarly, students will not be allowed to join the event after departure from Kentridge High School. If a graduate chooses to break the rules, the student will be removed from the party and the parent or guardian will be contacted to come get their student.

**Where is the Senior Night Party?** The location of the celebration is a surprise for the students. The planning committee knows where your students are at all times. We keep it a surprise for several reasons: Primarily, it is for safety. This event is for the 2010 class only and we do not want uninvited participants; we simply want it to be a surprise for the students!

### **What to Bring and What NOT to bring:**

- Photo ID is required in order to board the assigned bus
- A warm jacket or long sleeve sweatshirt
- Necessary medications/contact lens cases and solutions.  
Medications must be checked in and may be accessed any time they are needed during the night.
- No electronic devices, i.e. cell phones and ipods
- No money is needed/required
- No bags, purses or backpacks will be allowed

**All unauthorized items will be confiscated and held until end of event**

### **Personal Medications:**

Any student needing medications during the event need to indicate this on the medical release form. Medications should be in a prescription container and checked in upon arrival at KR High School before boarding the bus.

### **Check in Procedures and Security**

Please have your students at the Kentridge High School Main Gym at 9:30pm on June 12, 2010. All permission slips and medical release forms must be signed before your student will be allowed on the buses. There will be least 1 chaperone for every 25 students. KSD Security and Event Security will be present at the event.

### **Evening Itinerary**

- 9:30-10:30 PM: Check-in at Kentridge Main Gym, load buses
- 10:30 PM: Buses depart promptly
- 11:00 PM – 5:30 AM: Senior Night Party Activities
- 5:30 AM – 6:00 AM: Travel back to Kentridge High School
- 6:00 AM: Parents pick up students at Kentridge High School bus loop

We encourage you not to leave your car at the school parking lot overnight. Kentridge High School PTSA and the 2010 Senior Night Party Committee will not be responsible for damage done to vehicles.
